

Glocal Global Spring School Program 2023 in Tokyo Tech Design for Humanity – Preservation and Utilization of Water - Application Guide

This is an intensive program in problem solving and idea creation dealing with world-scale problems, for approximately 40 graduate school students from doctoral and master's degree programs, and professional master's degree program, with different academic or professional background.

“Glocal” is a new internationalization viewpoint that develops excellent “local” technologies and ideas to those of “global” scale.

Under the theme “Design for Humanity: Preservation and Utilization of Water,” we aim to envision projects that contribute to solving “global” issues related to preservation and utilization of water starting from the point of view of “local.”

Graduate students participate in discussions, activities, modeling, and poster presentation working in mixed groups. They can acquire the ability of leadership as a researcher or an entrepreneur, interdisciplinary knowledge and communication skills. In addition, the students will be able to create a collaboration and establish networks with researchers in other specialties, understand the extraprofessional knowledge, and obtain new viewpoints by cultural exchanges.

In the final session, each team will participate in poster presentation.

This Glocal Global Spring School Program is coordinated by faculty members of Tokyo Tech who worked as coaches at the Imperial College London - Tokyo Tech Global Fellows Programme in 2018 and 2019.

[Eligibility]

Graduate Student (Master's Program^{*1}, Professional Master's Degree Program^{*1}, and Doctoral Program), Special Auditing Student^{*2}, Research Student^{*2}, International Exchange Student^{*3}, who can participate in all sessions throughout the four days.

- *1 Students entering Tokyo Tech in September 2022 are not eligible to participate in the program. This program corresponds to a 500-level course, and the students can register for 500-level Humanities and Social Science courses six months after their entrance.
- *2 The enrollment to the courses is limited via the requested procedure. The procedure may incur expenses (e.g., examination fee, entrance fee, tuition fee, etc.).
- *3 The entrance is limited and participation permission is obtained only via the requested procedure. The procedure may incur expenses (e.g., examination fee, entrance fee, tuition fee, etc.).
- *4 (*2, *3) Another procedure is required.
